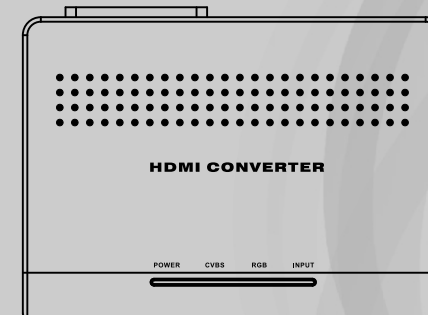

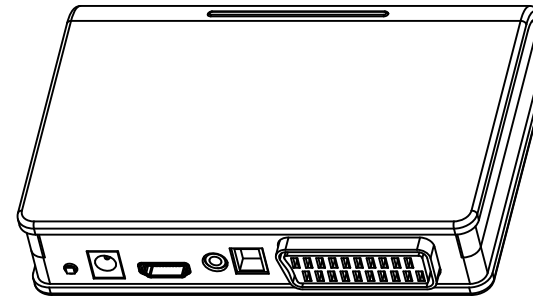

■ INTRODUCTION

Grandbeing's HS0101-001 is a HDMI to SCART converter. It converts HDMI input into SCART output (CVBS or RGB). User could use it to connect the HDMI equipment to the SCART interface TV set. The output video screen aspect ratio of this converter is 4:3 only.

HS0101-001 also provide L/R audio output for Stereo Speaker System and OPTICAL audio output for Hi-Fi System.

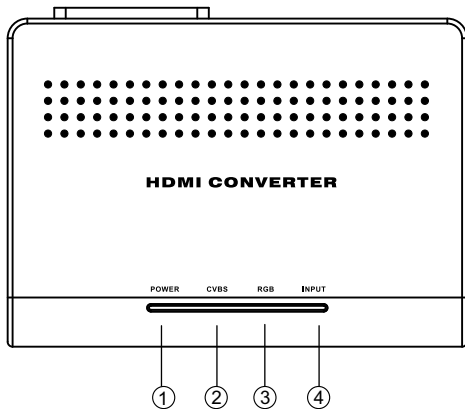

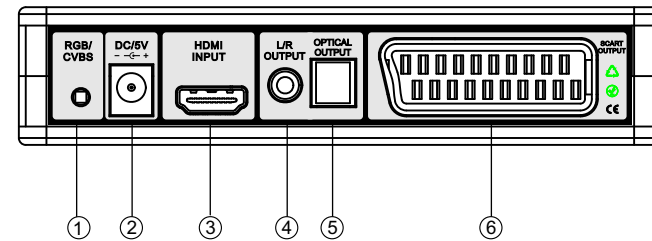
■ PANEL DESCRIPTIONS

•▶ Top Panel



1. Indicator of power.
2. Indicator of SCART CVBS output.
3. Indicator of SCART RGB output.
4. Indicator of HDMI input.

•▶ Rear Panel



1. Button for choosing CVBS or RGB output format.
2. Power input.
3. HDMI input.
4. L/R analog audio output.
5. OPTICAL audio output.
6. SCART output.

■ CONNECT AND OPERATION

- 1) Connect the HDMI source into HS0101-001. (HDMI cables are optional)
- 2) Connect the SCART display equipment in to HS0101-001. (Output cables are optional)
- 3) Power on the input source you want to show.
- 4) Connect the power supply into HS0101-001 and turn on the display you want to watch.
- 5) Use the button to set SCART output format to CVBS or RGB.
- 6) Notice you can also use L/R analog audio output or OPTICAL audio output for external audio system.

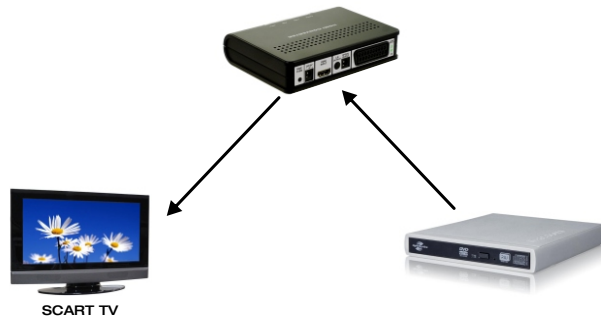

■ Maintenance

Clean this unit with a soft, dry cloth. Never use alcohol, paint thinner or benzene to clean this unit.

■ Product Service

1) Damage requiring service: The unit should be serviced by qualified service personnel if:

- The DC power supply cord or AC adaptor has been damaged;
- Objects or liquids have gotten into the unit;
- The unit has been exposed to rain;
- The unit does not operate normally or exhibits a marked change in performance;
- The unit has been dropped or the cabinet has been damaged.

2) Servicing Personnel: Do not attempt to service the unit beyond that described in these operating instructions. Refer all other servicing to authorized servicing personnel.

3) Replacement parts: When parts need replacing ensure the servicer uses parts specified by the manufacturer or parts that have the same characteristics as the original parts. Unauthorized substitutes may result in fire, electric shock, or other hazards.

4) Safety check: After repairs or service, ask the servicer to perform safety checks to confirm that the unit is in proper working condition.

■ WARRANTY

If your product does not work properly because of a defect in materials or workmanship, Grandbeing Company (referred to as "the warrantor") will, for the length of the period indicated as below, (parts(1) year, labor (90) days) which starts with the date of original purchase ("Limited Warranty period"), at its option either (a) repair your product with new or refurbished parts, or (b) replace it with a new or a refurbished product. The decision to repair or replace will be made by the warrantor. During the "Labor" Limited Warranty period there will be no charge for labor. During the "Parts" warranty period, there will be no charge for parts. You must mail-in your product during the warranty period. This Limited Warranty is extended only to the original purchaser and only covers product purchased as new. A purchase receipt or other proof of original purchase date is required for Limited Warranty service.

■ Mail-In Service

When shipping the unit, carefully pack and send it prepaid, adequately insured and preferably in the original carton. Include a letter detailing the complaint and provide a day time phone and/or email address where you can be reached.

IF REPAIR IS NEEDED DURING THE LIMITED WARRANTY PERIOD THE PURCHASER WILL BE REQUIRED TO FURNISH A SALES RECEIPT/PROOF OF PURCHASE INDICATING DATE OF PURCHASE, AMOUNT PAID AND PLACE OF PURCHASE. CUSTOMER WILL BE CHARGED FOR THE REPAIR OF ANY UNIT RECEIVED WITHOUT SUCH PROOF OF PURCHASE.

■ Limited Warranty Limits And Exclusions
